

EXISTING TREE WATERING

Every time a tree is watered, the soil should be thoroughly saturated to a depth of at least 2 to 3 feet and at least as wide as the tree well. Immediately after planting, new trees should be watered daily for the first 2 to 3 days, then use the appropriate schedule, depending on time of year / temperature. Very slow and deep watering is always recommended.

These watering schedules are based on average conditions in the area. They should be followed for at least the first 2 years after planting.

Fertilizing! One month after planting begin regular fertilizing with custom blended fertilizers and nutrients, which are available at any of our locations or may be purchased online.
